6. Obtain a 360° vision of the nuclear industry by participating in tours of nuclear power plants, nuclear companies, and federal organizations such as Plant Vogtle, ENERCON, CRANE Nuclear, U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission Training Center, and U.S. Department of Energy national laboratories.
7. Gain practical experience in internships and Co-Ops offered by various nuclear companies and federal organizations.
